"At the beginning of OrKidstra @ Home, I was pretty nervous, but playing the violin online and keeping in touch with my friends has really helped me through the pandemic."












Who we are

OrKidstra is a social development program for children aged 5 to 18 living in under-served areas of Ottawa, Canada.

Our mission is to empower kids and build community through the universal language of music. We carry out this mission by providing children from low-income families with free group and individual music lessons and the chance to learn important life skills like respect, compassion, teamwork, and responsibility through playing and singing together.

Our vision is a future where all children and youth have the opportunity to find their voice and build their potential through music.

Our mandate is to give children from under-served communities the opportunity to learn and make music together, and the chance to benefit from the individual skills and community values inherent in music-making.

Programs*

KiddlyWinks is a fun music and movement program. Ages 5-8. (in-school/after-school)

KidSingers is an upbeat choir program. 8 years + (after-school)

KidPlayers explores the joy of playing wind and brass instruments. 8 years + (after-school)

KidStringers explores the joy of playing string instruments. 8 years + (after-school)

KidDrummers explores the world of rhythm, music theory, and creativity. 8 years + (after-school)

OrKidstra senior level students explore playing wind, brass, and string instruments. 12 years + (after-school)

To creatively meet the challenges of online programming, OrKidstra also introduced new programming to OrKidstra @ Home in 2020-21 including a Masterclass, Buddy Mentors, KidComposers, Improvisation and much more.

Key Events of 2020–2021

July 13 - August 21, 2020 – OrKidstra offers its first-ever online summer programming with OrKidstra @ Home: Summer Edition!

October 13, 2020 – OrKidstra begins its 14th season with OrKidstra @ Home online programing.

December 18, 2020 – The online premiere of "OrKidstra's Virtual Winter Celebration!"

February 15, 2021 – OrKidstra virtually performs as part of the BeaverTails Ottawa Ice Dragon Boat Festival.

March 11, 2021 – Beginner and Junior students perform a virtual showcase.

March 24, 2021 – OrKidstra marks one year of OrKidstra @ Home online programming

April 29, 2021 – Intermediate and Senior students perform a virtual showcase.

June 1, 2021 – OrKidstra celebrates Intergenerational Day through a collaboration with the Canadian Showtime Chorus and iGen Ottawa.

June 10, **2021** – The premiere of "OrKidstra End-of-Year Virtual Celebration," featuring a graduation ceremony for seven OrKidstra Graduates!

2020-21!

Throughout 2020-21, OrKidstra @ Home online programming helped students stay connected to music, each other, and their community. First launched in late March 2020, as an innovative response to the challenges of COVID-19, OrKidstra @ Home and OrKidstra @ Home: Summer Edition combined creativity and technology in a fun and accessible way to help benefit OrKidstra students of all ages and empower them to continue building success – and brighten their days – with music at home.

Thanks to your generous support, in 2020-21, OrKidstra @ Home grew its weekly, after-school online programming to over 125 hours per week of live programming including group and individual music lessons, virtual celebrations, online activities, and new programs like Masterclass, Buddy Mentors, and improvisation and composition classes.

Encourages playing together to teach kids how to build a harmonious community.


Supports peer-to-peer structure, which breaks down barriers and fosters friendship.
